Q: Will the CBP website records include an extension of stay or change of status approved by USCIS?

A: No. CBP currently does not have plans to make this information accessible to travelers (or their representatives) through the CPB website (www.cbp.gov/l94). CBP will have access to the extension of stay and change of status information, which will allow CBP to determine that a person who extends or changes status after arriving has not overstayed even though the expiration date has been reached on the publicly accessible I-94 record. As part of its comments on the Interim Final Rule, AILA has recommended that CBP allow the data it accesses from USCIS to populate the CBP I-94 web portal so that travelers could print out this information, too.
